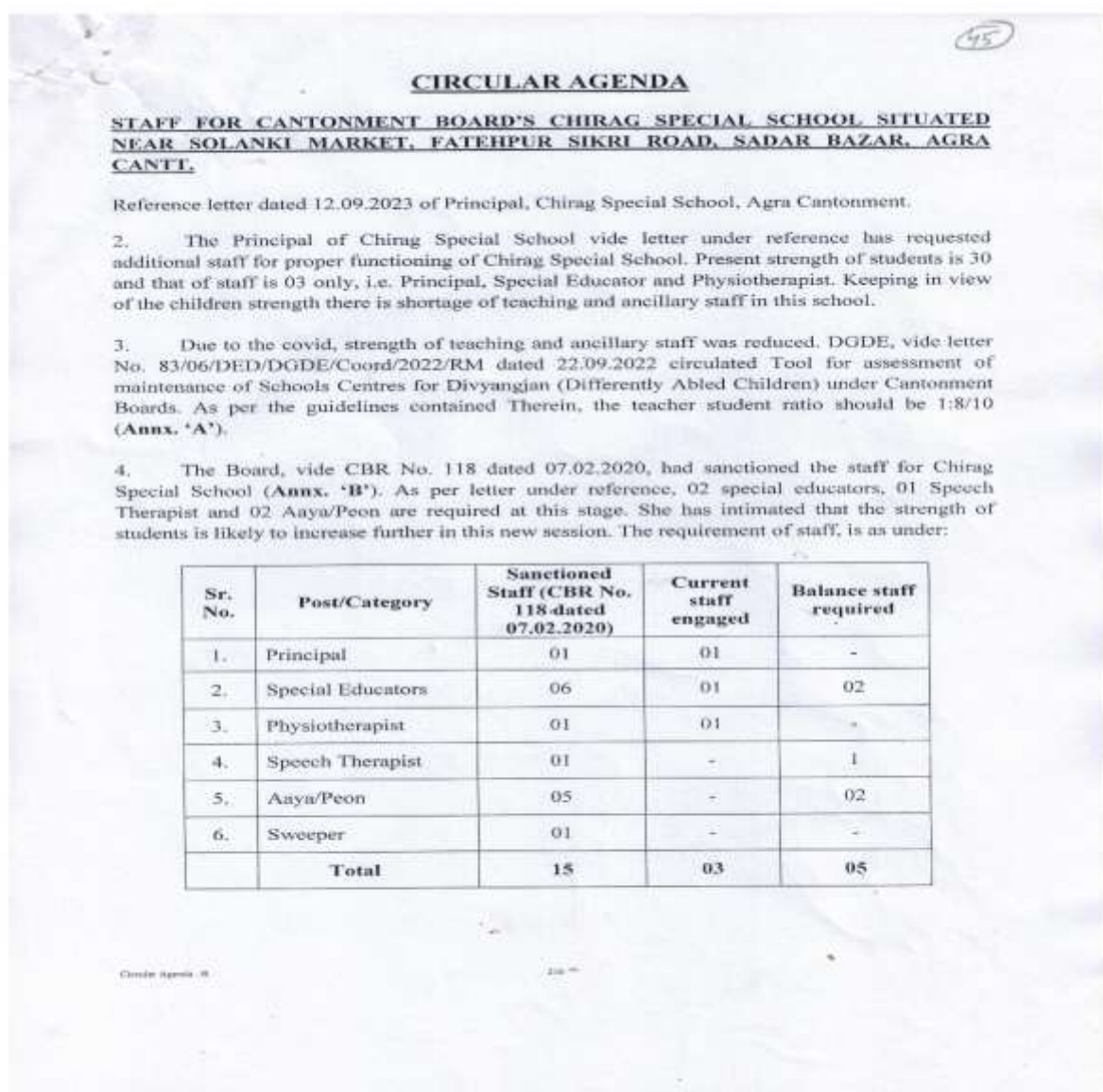

It is intimated that Cantonment General Hospital, Agra Cantonment is a 30 bedded hospital providing secondary level health care to the residents of Cantonment and neighbouring areas.

2. Cantonment General Hospital has an annual foot fall of more than 30,000 patients in OPD and more than 1000 patients in IPD. The hospital also conducts more than 100 deliveries and L.S.C.S. operations in a year.

3. However, as on date the CGH does not have the lab facilities for pathology & radiology. It is recommended that Cantonment Board, Agra, may enter into a contract with renowned local laboratory, having a centre in Agra, so that patients coming to CGH may avail the tests at reduced/discounted rates. The draft terms & conditions of the NIT are enclosed.


4. In this regard quotations may be invited for the said purpose as per following BOQ.

**Note:**

1. Room/Space Digital X-Ray Machines will be provided free of cost. However all other machineries/ equipment required for shall be provided by the contractor.
2. Also, cost on repair/annual Maintenance of all machineries/ equipment shall be borne by the contractor.
3. All equipment and day to day operational cost on consumables /reagents, X-Ray films etc. shall be borne by the contractor.
4. All technicians along with requisite supporting staff are to be provided by individuals/doctors/ firm.
5. Electricity charges are to be borne by the individuals/doctors/firm for the space being used by him.
6. All procedure/tests to be done as per CGHS rate which shall only be collected by individuals/doctors/firm from patient and percentage concession on CGHS rates is to be quoted in this BOQ.

8. In case of more than one application is received, then the individual/doctors/firm etc. shall be shortlisted based on highest percentage concession provider (On CGHS rates).
9. All the dispute/cases arising out of medico-legal issued shall be responsibility of the individual/Doctor/firms and in no case CB Agra shall be held responsible.
10. The PATHOLOGY & RADIOLOGY (X-RAY, ULTRASOUND etc.) SETUP shall run on 24X7 basis.

**REQUEST REGARDING PARKING OF VEHICLES ON CANTT. BOARD'S LAND, G.L.R. SY. NO.233-38, CLASS 'C' LAND :**

To consider the letter dated 26.12.2023 received from Sh. R.S. Sawhney (President) Gurdwara Sri Kalgidhar, Sadar Bazar, Agra Cantt. requesting for use of space of Cantt. Board's land comprising G.L.R. Sy.No. 233-38 Sadar Bazar, Agra Cantt. for the purpose of parking of vehicles by the general public. Gurdwara authorities have requested that Cantt. Board's land of Sy. No.233-38 Sadar Bazar, Agra Cantt. may be allowed for parking of vehicles since the same is being used as a garbage dumpyard by the neighborhood houses/properties thereby causing unhygienic conditions:

2. It is stated that G.L.R Sy.No.233-38, Sadar Bazar, Agra Cantonment is classified as class 'C' land, situated within notified civil area, under the management of Cantonment Board Agra. As per G.L.R record, the land area is 1,660.00 Square Feet and the same is described for "Public recreation ground".

3. The site was inspected by field staff of this office and it was observed that the same is currently in unhygienic condition, and is being used for dumping of waste by the residents of the area. Further, since the site is lying vacant, there is also chance of encroachment by unscrupulous elements at some point of time.

4. In view of the above, it is recommended that the land comprising G.L.R Sy.No.233-38, Agra Cantonment may be allowed to Gurdwara authorities for period of one year, for parking of vehicles by the persons visiting Gurdwara as well as by the general public, subject to the following conditions:-

(a) No permanent/temporary construction work shall be carried out.  
(b) No hoarding or sign board of any entity/individual shall be placed on the site.  
(c) The applicant shall maintain general cleanliness of the site.  
(d) Cantonment Board may utilize the land/site for any other purpose at any point of time,  
(e) No fee of any kind shall be collected for using the site.





Online tender was published in newspapers and online defence procurement portal (<https://defproc.gov.in>) on 22.11.2023 having **TENDER ID 2023\_DGDE\_629307\_1** for capturing, sterilization and anti-rabies vaccination of stray dogs as per ABC/ARV (Animal Birth Control/Anti Rabies Vaccination) scheme in Cantonment Board Agra. However due to insufficient no. of participants (01 participants), the tender was cancelled. Retender was published of the same in newspapers and online defence procurement portal (<https://defproc.gov.in>) on 15.12.2023 for the said tender with the Tender Id **2023\_DGDE\_629307\_2**.

2. Three firms namely, **M/S Maa Bagulamukhi Seva Samiti, BT Compund 1109, Shukhar Nagar, Indra Gandhi Ward, Jabalpur, Mp**; **M/S Daksh Foundation, VPO Bamani, Khair, Aligarh, Up** and **M/S Siddhant Society For Animal Care Samiti, 501 Aakrati Orced, Saugat Apartment,Gwalior, Mp** participated in the tender whose technical bids were opened on 26.12.2023. The technical evaluation of all the three firms were done in which all the three firms were qualified. The financial bid was opened on 03.01.2024 for all the three technically qualified firms.

3. The Lowest e-bid has been received from **M/S Maa Bagulamukhi Seva Samiti, Bt Compund 1109, Shukhar Nagar, Indra Gandhi Ward, Jabalpur, MP** for the said work as per attached e- bid summary from <https://defproc.gov.in>.

4. The estimated cost for AMC for capturing, sterilization and anti-rabies vaccination of stray dogs including GST was proposed as Rs. 1200/= per dog. The rate quoted by L1 bidder is 8.58 % less than the estimated cost.

5. **M/S Maa Bagulamukhi Seva Samiti, BT Compund 1109, Shukhar Nagar, Indra Gandhi Ward, Jabalpur, MP** is the L1 bidder and the bid amount of Rs. 1097.00/= including GST for capturing, sterilization and anti-rabies vaccination of stray dogs as per ABC/ARV (Animal Birth Control/Anti Rabies Vaccination) scheme in Cantonment Board, Agra is reasonable.

6. As per tender terms and condition, The ABC Campuses shall be provided to bidder including Operation Theater + Kennels + Well Constructed Rooms + other basic infrastructure like Operation Tables, Drip Stands, Autoclave and Basic Furniture. Also written undertaking shall be taken from L1 bidder that the Catching Technique, Transportation Protocols, De-wormers, Vaccines, Drugs, Suture Material, Anesthetic Protocol, Surgical Protocol, handling & Maintenance of dogs shall be followed as per the "Standard Operative Procedure for Sterilization of Stray Dogs Under The Animal Birth Control Program" published by AWBI. A minimum 02 Qualified Veterinary Doctors having collective experience of not less than 2000 ABC-ARV Surgeries of stray dogs, 02 Paravets & 6 dog Catches shall be provided by the L1 bidder.


7. Payment for the ABC-ARV shall be made based on Organ Count Basis, verified by the authorized person of Cantonment Board Agra. Organ Count may be re-verified by AWBI/SAWB or State Government or Station Health Officer (SHO). The organs need to be preserved till the time as instructed by appropriate authority.

8. In view of the above, it is recommended to allot the work for capturing, sterilization and anti-rabies vaccination of stray dogs to **M/S Maa Bagulamukhi Seva Samiti, BT Compund 1109, Shukhar Nagar, Indra Gandhi Ward, Jabalpur, MP**.
